

# Code of Conduct

Inclusivity is at the heart of Robotics for All's mission and it is no different for this event. Our goal is to give students a collaborative, challenging, and rewarding experience, where participants can use their computer science skills to tackle real world issues. Every participant is expected to contribute to creating an environment free of harassment, where ideas are welcomed, and everyone feels safe.

We do not tolerate disrespect or bullying in any form, we believe everyone has the right to participate in a safe and welcoming event.

We expect all attendees, sponsors, guests, and organizers to abide by the following policies. Failure to do so means Robotics For All and the event organizers may take any action they deem appropriate, including removing the offender from the event.

## 1. Respect For All

- To keep the event environment safe, we expect participants to show the same high level of respect to every other participant, regardless of gender expression, ethnicity, sexual orientation, religion, nationality, legal status, disability, political stances, or any other factor that can be discriminated against.

## 2. Support For All

- We expect all participants to support each other's ideas, giving practical and critical advice when necessary.
- We want to emphasize the idea of "yes, and", building off of each other's ideas to create something better.

## 3. Compassion For All

- We expect participants to show compassion and friendliness to their fellow attendees, even if they are on another team. The goal of this event is not to win, but to grow together.
